



## Conversation Assistants in Madrid Schools

Saint Louis University-Madrid partners with Catholic (BEDA) and secular private schools in the Madrid area to provide English assistants. Conversation assistants (*auxiliares*) provide oral input and practice as a supplement to elementary and high school students' English language classes. They are not responsible for lesson planning, though they meet with the English instructors once a week to review content and student progress.

Conversation Assistants must meet the following requirements:

- Be a registered student at SLU-Madrid
- Be native English speakers or from a country where English is the official language
- Have prior classroom management experience
- Have prior experience teaching children or teaching English
- Have health and accident insurance through SLU
- Be available to teach from September through May
- Be at least 20 years old
- Have an intermediate level of Spanish
- Attend a day-long orientation session in September or October

Salaries are normally proportionate to approximately 300 euros gross/month for 6 hours of work per week, but may vary slightly depending on the school. Most schools submit their requests for Language Assistants each September; applications are accepted from June through September.
