



Conversation Assistants in Madrid Schools

Saint Louis University-Madrid partners with Catholic and secular private schools in the Madrid area to provide English assistants. Conversation assistants (*auxiliares*) provide oral input and practice as a supplement to elementary and high school students' English language classes. They are not responsible for lesson planning, though they meet with the English instructors once a week to review content and student progress.

Conversation Assistants must meet the following requirements:

- Be a registered student at SLU-Madrid
- Be native English speakers or from a country where English is the official language
- Have prior classroom management experience
- Have prior experience teaching children or teaching English
- Be available to teach from September through May
- Be at least 18 years old
- Have an intermediate level of Spanish

Compensation varies, depending on the school, and starts at 8€/hour. Some schools may require 6 hours per week, others 20. Most schools submit their requests for Language Assistants each September; applications are accepted from June through September. If you are interested in applying, please send your resume to bolsatrabajo-madrid@slu.edu. Eligibility is determined by your previous teaching and classroom experience. Placements are not guaranteed, and very few opportunities are available.
