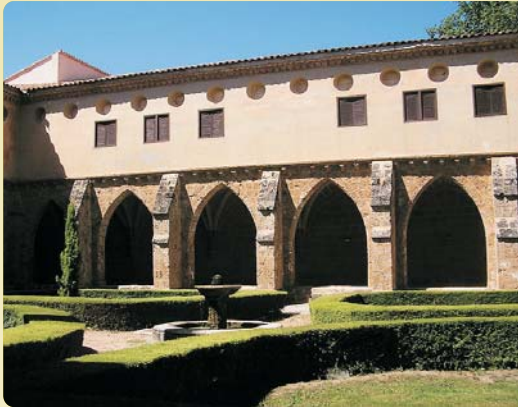




GET TO KNOW YOUR PEERS, GET TO KNOW MADRID



Day trip to the Monasterio de Piedra - 45€ Saturday, September 8th (8:30 am)

The *Monasterio de Piedra* was founded in 1194 when Alonso II granted an arab castle to the monks of Pablet to build a monastery in the hopes of consolidating Christianity in the Area. Legend says that this monastery is where the first chocolate candy was made. The natural park of *Monasterio de Piedra* offers an unbelievable experience, with a 2.5 hour walk through a lush parkland of waterfalls and grottos hidden in one of the driest areas of the region of Aragón.

Day trip to Toledo - 45€ Sunday, September 9th (9:00 am)

Toledo is a World Heritage site located just outside of Madrid. It is known as the “city of the three cultures” because Christians, Arabs and Jews lived together in this city for centuries. Behind its walls, Toledo preserves an artistic and cultural legacy in the form of churches, palaces, fortresses, mosques and synagogues.



Day trip to Salamanca - 45€ Saturday, September 15th (8:30 am)

Salamanca has been declared “City of Mankind’s Heritage” by UNESCO, and is best known for its university founded in the beginning of the 13th century. Don’t leave Spain without visiting one of the most breathtaking Renaissance cities in Europe and exploring its Romanesque and Baroque architecture.

Day trip to Segovia - 45€ Sunday, September 16th (9:00 am)

Segovia is one of the must-do day trips while in Madrid. Join us in visiting this World Heritage site, famous for the Roman aqueduct that stands tall in the center of the old quarter. In addition, you will see numerous Romanesque churches and the Cathedral and Fortress (Castle).



Sign up at the Finance Office, Avda. del Valle 34. Day trip sign-up closes at 5:30pm on the Wednesday before each event.

Day trips are 45€ each and include transportation to and from the University in private coach along with a guided visit in English and entrance fees. Minimum of 20 people required. Fees are non-refundable on or after the date the excursion takes place. Online registration cannot be modified or cancelled after September 3.
